QUEENSCLIFF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING SUNDAY 6th AUGUST 2017

In accordance with the Clubs Constitution and the Associations Incorporations Act 2009 Queenscliff SLSC hereby gives notice that the following changes to the Constitution will be considered for approval at the Annual General Meeting of QSLSC on the 6th August 2017:

8.7.1 Distinguished Service Award

Current Constitution:

A Distinguished Service Award may be awarded to a member by virtue of a meritorious rescue performed by the member or who otherwise has given extraordinary service to surf lifesaving for a minimum period of fifteen years, the majority of which has been with the Club.

Recommended Change to Constitution:

Deletion of "for a minimum period of fifteen years:

A Distinguished Service Award may be awarded to a member by virtue of a meritorious rescue performed by the member or who otherwise has given extraordinary service to surf lifesaving, the majority of which has been with the Club.

8.7.2 Life Membership.

Current Constitution:

A member may be eligible to be awarded Life Membership if they have received a Distinguished Service Award and continued to provide exceptional service for an additional five years minimum.

Recommended Change to Constitution:

Deletion of "additional five years minimum"

A member may be eligible to be awarded Life Membership if they have received a Distinguished Service Award and continued to provide exceptional service.

8.7 Club Honours for Members

Current Constitution:

A Member must accept or reject the Club's resolution to confer Club Honours in writing.

Recommended Change to Constitution:

Deletion of "A Member must accept or reject the Club's resolution to confer Club Honours in writing".



MARKETING AND SPONSORSHIP DIRECTOR:

The Role

Lead the Club's brand awareness activities, marketing for new members and the development of financial support from existing and new sponsors and be responsible for the control and implementation of all fundraising activities and shall account to the Treasurer for the results. Shall submit all proposals to the Board for Approval. Specific elements of the role include:

- Develop a Marketing Plan and Budget for the Club, outlining planned activities for the year ahead
- Develop specific initiatives to market the Club to potential members in the local community as well as promote the Club and its range of activities
- Actively seek out sponsorship opportunities for the Club
- Liaise with Board and sections about their needs that can be funded by sponsorship and tailor Club's sponsorship proposal template
- Negotiate sponsorship benefits and deliverables with potential sponsors in accordance with the Club's sponsorship hierarchy
- Submit and negotiate sponsorship proposals
- Manage sponsorship relationship with the sponsor or with other club members who have liaison and management roles for existing sponsors
- Update the Sponsorship pages on the Club's website
- Ensure recognition on sponsored equipment and at Carnivals and in Club's Annual Report
- Ensure sponsor representatives are invited to Carnivals and events eg AGM, Boat Launch
- Liaise with Sponsors for infrequent advertorial pieces for Queensie News
- Seek out donations for the Club either in cash or in kind for Queensie events such as Swim for Saxon, Golf Day and Club Presentation Night and manage appropriate recognition for large donations
- Post pieces to Club's social media accounts about the Club and sponsors
- Attend monthly Board Meetings

Noel Ferry in his Younger years

A young strapping and very handsome Noel Ferry in charge of the very first Surf Rescue Power Boats on the Northern Beaches of Sydney. In the 1970's Noel performed many rescues in dangerous surf. One particular rescue a young man was being smashed against rocks in a wild sea Noel maneuvered the Power Boat with precision between sets giving his co-lifesaver only seconds to grab the young man by the hair and drag him aboard as Noel powered away out running the next set of gigantic waves. Noel joined the Queenscliff Surf Lifesaving Club at the age of 14 and is to this day the clubs longest standing member.
