IMPORTANT CARNIVAL INFORMATION

COMPETITION INFORMATION

There is no Competitor Registration required on the day of the event.

All competitors must have their **Age Group & Competitor Entry ID** clearly marked on their left wrist or left arm prior to marshalling. e.g. U9 42. The **Competitor Entry ID** will be published on the Carnival Programs web page prior to the event – <https://www.surflifesaving.net.au/surf-sports/carnivals/programs/>

For relay teams, if there are more than one team per event, please distinguish the teams as A, B C etc, and ensure that this is written on their arms before the relays.

Competitors must compete in their own age group only, in both individual and team events.

We ask all competitors not to arrive to the beach earlier than 30 minutes before their start time where possible, to minimize the number of people at the beach.

TEAM/AGE MANAGERS

Team Managers/Age Managers will be required to nominate to be able to enter the staging and competition area. Upon arrival they will need to scan the event QR code at the entry to the Field of Play, and they will then receive a wrist band which will provide them access.

PARENTS & SPECTATORS

We encourage parents to drop off their children and leave the area. We will allow for a small number of spectators at the carnival in designated spectator areas only, with the following provisions –

- All spectators must maintain social distancing of a minimum of 1.5m from anyone who is not from the same household
- All spectators must check in to the event using the carnival QR code that is available on the Carnival Program webpage and will also be available at the event.

COVID Marshals will be in attendance to monitor attendance numbers and ensure appropriate social distancing is being adhered to. Only designated team managers / age managers will be permitted into the field of play. Spectators are not allowed to enter the field of play.

STATE QUALIFICATION

At this stage it is highly likely that for some or all categories of events at the 2021 State Age Championships, there will be a **qualification** requirement. At this stage exact details are unknown, other than the determination of the qualification criteria will be the responsibility of each Branch.

As such, whilst we have yet to determine what the criteria will be for Sydney Northern Beaches clubs, we will be keeping the results from this carnival should they be required to assist in any future qualification process.
