

QUEENSCLIFF SLSC VOLUNTEERING INFORMATION

On behalf of Queenscliff SLSC Board and all club members a sincere thank you for volunteering to assist at the NSW State Surf Life Saving Championships from 23rd February to and including 5th March 2023.

Volunteer Shifts:

You will receive an email via SignUp two days before your designated shift to remind you of your shift time and what you are doing.

Attendance at your shift:

Team Leaders will meet you in the area where your shift will be 15 minutes prior to shift start. If your Team Leader is unable to meet you, they will have designated the meet and greet to another member.

Team Leaders will brief their volunteers on what is required of them and where they would like you to assist/work.

Team Leaders will ask you to check in via a QR code. The initial check in will require some personal information however the check in will remember your details for your next check in.

On completion of your shift, you will receive a Food and Drink token, this can be used at the BBQ or cold drink stand or bar for a beer or wine/champagne.

Shift Locations – Where to Meet your Team Leader:

Parking – please go to Keirle Park or Lagoon Parking or Hinkler, meet at Car Park entrance

Bar – upstairs in the club house – Peter Daley Room

BBQ – downstairs outside to the left of the beach entrance door to the club under cover

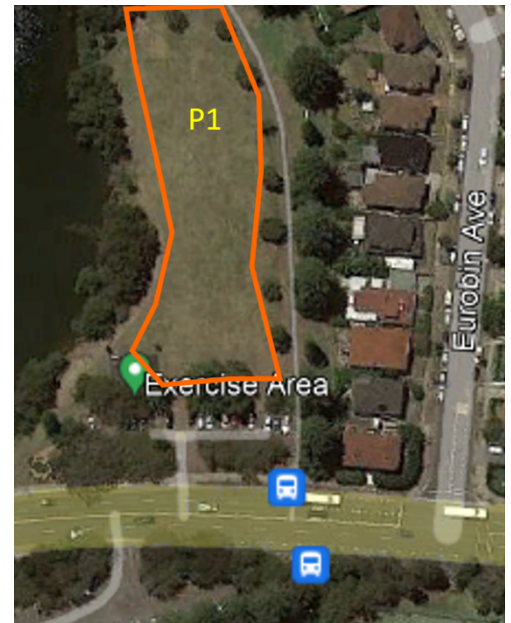
Officials Food – upstairs in the Bombora Pavillion

Cold Drinks – Patrol Shed area weekdays only

Beach Set Up and/or Pack Up – Under the clock tower outside club entrance

Crash Crew - Under the clock tower outside club entrance

P1 Lagoon South - Vehicles enter off Pittwater Road and enter the car park through council gates mid-way of asphalt carpark. You can only enter from the same side of the road as Lagoon South you cannot turn right into Lagoon South if you are heading North.



P2 – Keirle Park - Vehicles enter off Pittwater Road and enter the car park adjacent the skate park. Exit is a separate gate depicted in red. Do not turn right into Keirle Park if you are coming from North. Go around the roundabout and enter via same side of the road at Keirle Park.



P3 – Hinkler Reserve Vehicles enter from Pittwater Road – you can only enter from the same side of the road as Hinkler Reserve you cannot turn right into Hinkler Reserve if you are heading North.



What to Wear:

Please wear your Queenscliff SLSC Volunteering Shirt. If you volunteered last year, please wear your gear from 2022. For all new volunteers with 3 or more shifts, shirts can be collected from **Admin on Sunday, 19th February from 9.30am until 11am.**

If you are unable to collect your shirt and hat on the 19th February then please do so Monday to Friday 9.30am until 2.30pm or during SLSNSW State Titles 8am to 3pm

For all volunteers working on Beach Set and/or Pack Up, BBQ, Bar, Parking please wear closed in shoes do not wear thongs or open toe shoes.

Parking:

All volunteers will receive free parking either in the Lagoon Parking area if available or in Keirle Park. Please advise the volunteers on the gate your name and what you are volunteering for (eg BBQ shift).

However please note:

- Lagoon Parking - You can only enter from the same side of the road as Lagoon South you cannot turn right into Lagoon South if you are heading North away from Manly.
- Keirle Park - Do not turn right into Keirle Park if you are coming from North. Go around the roundabout and enter via same side of the road at Keirle Park
- Hinkler Reserve - You can only enter from the same side of the road as Hinkler Reserve you cannot turn right into Hinkler Reserve if you are heading North away from Manly.

BBQ and Drink Token:

Your Team Leader will provide you with a BBQ token and a drink token. These tokens can be used at the BBQ for food and for a drink either at the Cold Drink Stand or at the Bar upstairs in the club house for a beer, wine or champagne.

Shift Non-Attendance:

If you are unable to attend your shift, please ensure you contact your Team Leader at least 24 hours prior to attendance. If you are sick on the day, then please contact your Team Leader and/or Admin during office hours (8am-3pm).
